Guidelines for In-person Worship at Crawfordville UMC Beginning September 13, 2020

- 1. All persons ages 5+ in attendance will need to wear a mask inside the building. Masks need to be properly worn and fit over the nose.
- 2. We will have hand sanitizer stations at the doorways as you enter and leave.
- 3. We will have people sit in family and carpool groups with appropriate social distancing.
- 4. We will encourage people to converse outside after the service, not in the building.
- 5. We will discourage all physical contact (handshakes, hugs, and high-fives).
- 6. Singing will be limited due to singing increasing the spread of droplets and aerosols.
- 7. We will not pass offering plates, instead offerings should be placed in the designated giving boxes or given online at www.crawfordvilleumc.org
- 8. We will offer two services at 9:30 am and 11:00 am to limit occupancy.
- 9. Services will be between 35-40 minutes long and a few doors will be open for fresh air.
- 10. Every other row will be blocked for social distancing and alternated between services so each row will only be used only once on a given Sunday.
- 11. Between services we will air out the sanctuary and clean items that have been touched.
- 12. To keep things simple, we will not offer a staffed nursery, children's church, or Sunday school. These will come back at a later date. The worship service is the first step. The shorter service will make it easier for children to sit with their families.
- 13. Finally, households that are connected with in-person school due to contact with teachers, students, school staff, etc. are encouraged to attend the 11 am service due to their increased likelihood of exposure. This will allow the 9:30 am service to be available to our more senior members.
