Reflection on the Epiphany of the Lord

The Epiphany (Manifestation) of the Lord (January 6), is an older celebration among Christians than Christmas. Epiphany originally focused on the nativity (birth), incarnation, and baptism of Christ. Today, we celebrate the coming of the wise men (magi) who brought gifts to the Christ child on Epiphany. This marks the end of the Christmas cycle which began the First Sunday of Advent.

Church Father Irenaeus said this about the Epiphany of the Lord: “The Son of God “caused human nature to cling to God and to be one with God” so that “sin should be destroyed by man and man should go forth from death.”
